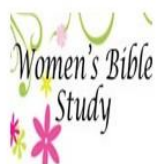

SFA PARISH CHRISTIAN INITIATION UPDATE



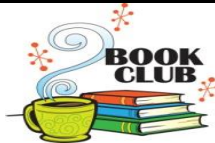
