Breaking Open the Word

1st Sunday of Lent ~ March 9th, 2025



Deuteronomy 26:4-10

"...Moses spoke, 'My father was a wandering Aramean who went to Egypt and lived there as an alien...and was maltreated and oppressed...'"

Moses knew what it was like to be 'the other,' 'the alien,' 'the immigrant' unwelcome in a different land. In what way do you see later-day 'Moses' in your present-day journey? How do you think the Lord would want you to treat these people?
