



Breaking Open the Word 2nd Sunday of Lent ~ March 16th, 2025

Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18

"... "I am the LORD who brought you from Ur of the Chaldeans..."

Are there days when you feel despondent? Where your soul seems ensnared in a nauseating as well as paralyzing death-grip of fear? During such moments, how have you sought to deal with such challenges? Have you reflected upon the innumerable times where frail, frightened faith-filled followers entreat God for help while wandering in the valley of despair? Can you see that you are of the spiritual lineage of Abram\Abraham? That you are not alone in your dark, desolate days? What happens when you turn to Our Lord and engage His eternal energy by praying and focusing on the 'things above?' Do you not feel like a person reborn?


