

My Dear Parishioners,

I wanted to write this short note to thank you for your continued support of St. Francis parish. It truly is a blessing to be here! When looking at the health of a parish, it goes beyond just finances; it's always good to look at the number of Baptisms, new family registrations, weddings and funerals. Here are last year's numbers for St. Francis:

Baptisms -131 (which is an incredible number for the size of our parish).

New Family Registrations – 139

(again, showing we are a parish people want to be a part of). **Funerals** – 43 (we always do our best to accommodate families, regardless of their parish affiliation, in their time of loss).

Weddings – 24 (Both at our church and some local venues).

Our parish is healthy! I wish I could give you a better update on the school, but it has been very stressful for the principal and I working with the Archdiocese and their lack of communication. I had an impromptu meeting with the Chief Financial Officer of the Archdiocese, along with the Chief Strategy Officer, the other week, and I wasn't too pleased. We are in a period of time where many people (rightly so) no longer trust the institutional church, therefore communication and transparency are key. We all deserve that. I promise I'll do my best to keep everyone in the loop. We love our Lord, and we love our faith and I'm confident things will work out in the big picture. There was a prayer composed in 1979 in honor of a hero of mine, Bishop Oscar Romero, and it's a prayer about "stepping back and taking the long view of things." I know the right thing, the moral thing, the ethical thing will be done to rebuild our school—a school that currently has a wait list and has been around for a century. I am confident the Archdiocese will do the right thing. God Bless all of you! In Christ,

Isaiah 50:4-7

"I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting." Have you ever suffered for your faith? How did you respond?

Philippians 2:6-11

"Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave..." How can Christ's self-emptying inspire your discipleship?

Luke 22:14-23:56

Throughout the Gospel reading, Luke emphasizes Jesus' freedom in the face of betrayal, lynching, and an indifferent police state. In Luke's account, although several characters in the passion narrative make decisions that leads to Jesus' death, none of them has real power. Jesus, by contrast, uses his freedom in the service of others. When he offered up his will in the garden, proclaimed to the high priest that he was the Son of Man, or asked God to forgive his murderers and receive his Spirit, he freely chose what was right. He did this despite his suffering, and his choice to do so made this use of his freedom an example to us. How can Jesus' gift of freedom help you overcome whatever holds you captive?




