

My Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter to everyone! I had mentioned it before, but I like when Easter occurs on a later date since the weather is a bit warmer and the hours of daylight are longer. I think that reflects the nature of the Easter season. Back in 2023, I was visiting the Holy Land for the first time in my life and was invited to concelebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Holy Sepulcher is the church of the resurrection— Christ was crucified, buried and resurrected in that location. The church of the Holy Sepulcher has an awesome history because there are actually two tombs—the Protestants have their own tomb and then the Catholics and Orthodox have the real one. What happened is interesting; the Protestant tomb is too old—it predates the time of Christ and cannot, historically, be His actual tomb. The other thing is that the city of Jerusalem has expanded over the years and, while the church is in the center of town nowadays, it was actually on the outskirts back in the time of our Lord, which puts it in the correct location according to scripture. Being in the center of Jerusalem at that ancient church was unreal. It was an incredible blessing to offer Mass at that empty tomb. It was an empty tomb because Christ is truly risen! Whenever I have down days, I just think of Christmas and Easter—we are a hope-filled church. Everyday can be a new beginning. The Lord loves us and is incredibly patient too. Happy Easter!

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of The Lord April 20th, 2025



Acts of the Apostles 10:34A, 37-43

The readings this Sunday show New Testament writers coming to terms with God's ability to wrest from even the worst tragedy a glorious reversal. Although subtle, a reversal of sorts also appears in this Sunday's First Reading. Peter, explaining the significance of Jesus' resurrection, describes the mission that Christ left the apostles. They are to preach forgiveness, even to the very people who killed him. How can you strengthen your ability to forgive?

Colossians 3:1-4

In today's Second Reading, Paul teaches that Jesus' resurrection gives us hope for a glorious end to our lives. When we die in faith, we rely on Christ to raise us as he himself rose. We rely on Christ's conquest of death to overcome our earthly misfortunes. How do you rely on Christ to overcome misfortune?

John 20:1-9

This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad. What evidence have you found that Christ is alive and at work?






