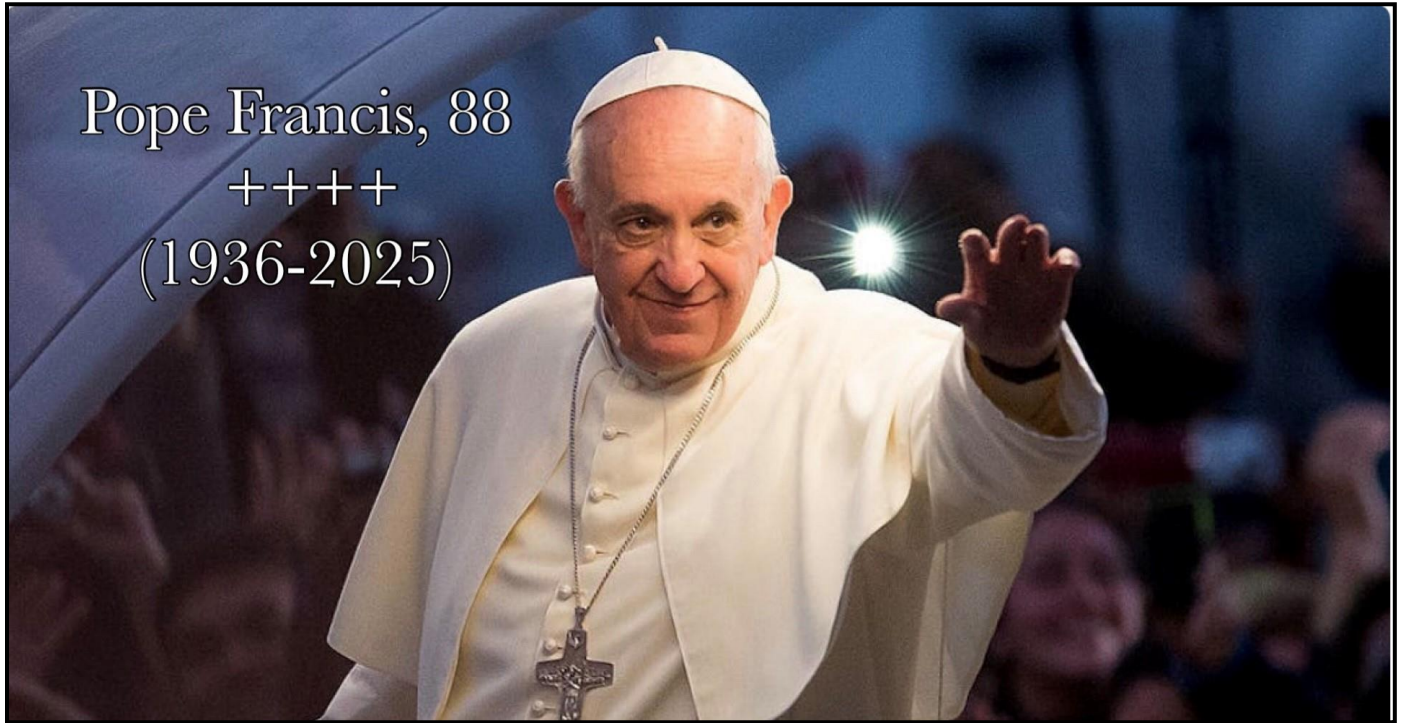

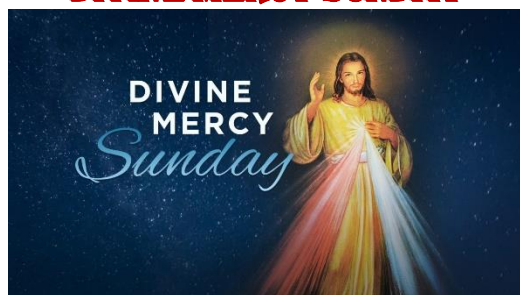
Our next collection for Saint John's Hospice will be the weekend of May 3 & 4
