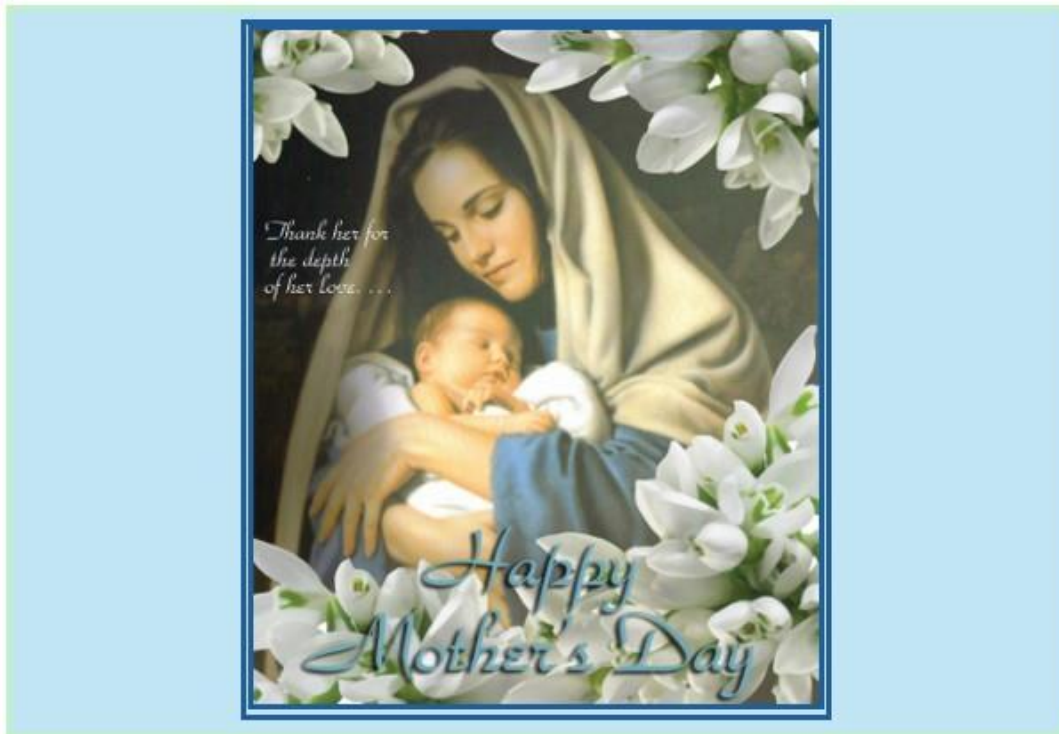

Mass of Remembrance

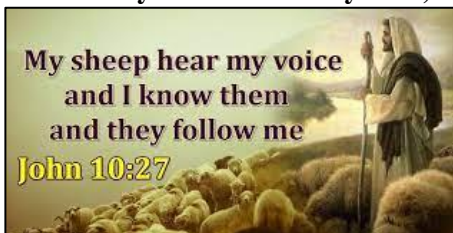
Saturday, May 17th 10:30AM

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD Fourth Sunday of Easter ~ May 11th, 2025



Acts of the Apostles 13: 14, 43-52

In the First Reading, we see a dispute developing between Paul and the Jews over the offer of the Gospel to the Gentiles. Paul reminds those among the Jewish community that God had instructed the Jewish people through the prophet Isaiah that Israel had a destiny to fulfill in spreading the worship of the One, true God to all nations. To what extent have you been faithful to the call to be an evangelizer?

Revelation 7: 9, 14B-17

“For the lamb who is in the center of the throne will shepherd them.” In this simple phrase is contained the miracle of the Incarnation. Christ’s role as mediator is expressed in dual designation as Lamb and Shepherd. In the cultures of the ancient Near east, the shepherd was a symbol of gentleness, authority, solicitude & power. How do you see the Lord shepherding you with these symbols?

John 10: 27-30

The Gospel indicates that sheep follow in the example of their shepherd, Jesus. Elsewhere in the Gospels, Jesus says, “I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.” How can you lay down your life for your fellow Christians each day?
