

Acts of the Apostles 14:21-27

The First Reading reminds us of the energy of a young and enthusiastic community of faith. MEMORIAL DAY ~ MAY 26th, 2025

Springfield American Legion Post 227 and Springfield Township, Delaware County again hosts Memorial Day parade and services, remembering all Springfield residents who made the ultimate sacrifice in the defense of our country and our community. 
<u>9:15 AM</u>: A brief Memorial Service will start in front of St. Francis Church World War II Memorial, 136 Saxer Avenue, Springfield, PA 19064, followed by a parade on Saxer Avenue and Powell Road to Old Central School

10:00 AM: Memorial Service at Old Central School This year we will be honoring and remembering United States Army 2nd Lt. Donald S. Weightman, a 1937 graduate of Springfield High School and Springfield resident who was a co-pilot of a B-17 Flying Fortress when on a bombing mission on February 10, 1944, the aircraft was heavily damaged and presumed lost in the North Sea attempting to return to their base in England. The aircraft and crew were never seen or heard from again.

At the time of his passing he had wife and one month old son. That son is now 81 years old and living in Ohio. He plans to travel to Springfield to attend the Memorial Day Service honoring his father.


