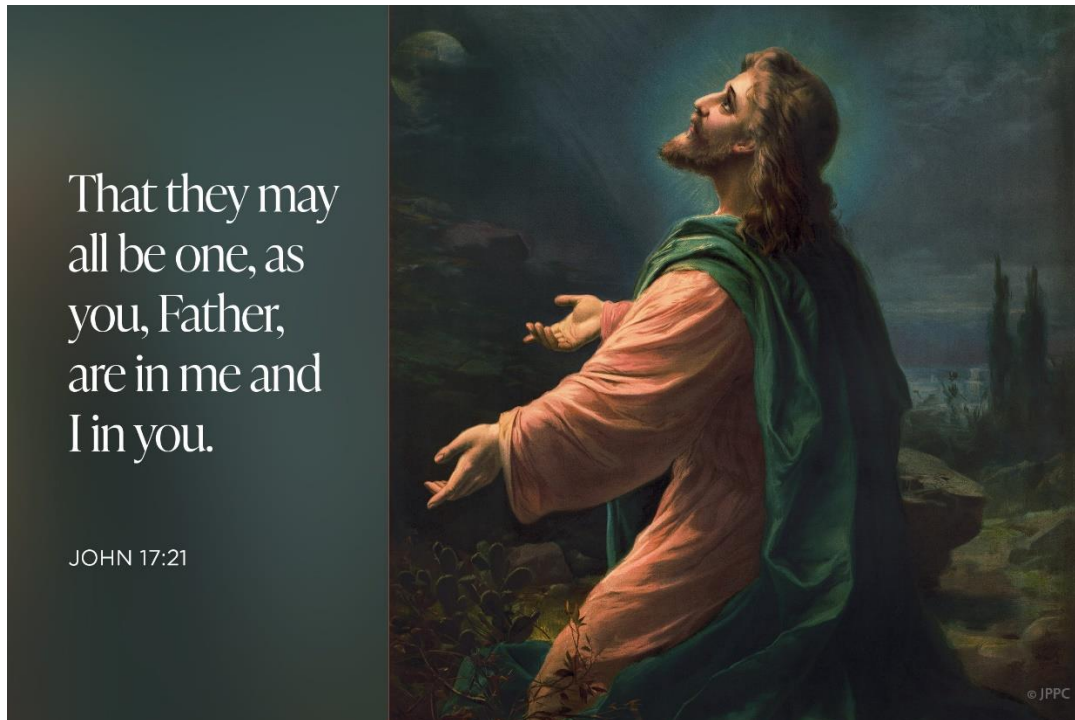

My Dear Parishioners,

I hope every enjoyed the Memorial Day Weekend. We all appreciate the weekend as the unofficial start of summer but, on a deeper level, we honor the men and women who have given their very lives in service to our nation. A good number of you may remember Bishop Fulton J. Sheen. It's crazy to think a Catholic bishop had an Emmy Award show on ABC in the 1950s called *Life is Worth Living*. For some reason, I've been watching clips of it recently. Bishop Sheen said that there is a difference between pain and sacrifice. Pain without love is mere suffering but pain coupled with love becomes an act of self-giving. Our soldiers went through pain out of love for our nation—that makes it a true act of self-giving. While you may not have had to make the ultimate sacrifice of giving your life, you all make daily sacrifices for your families and the ones you love. I truly admire that.

Last month, I, along with some members of our parish, went to Ireland. The trip went off without a hitch and the weather couldn't have been better. I wanted to buy a little memento of the trip, so I purchased a book called "*The Pocket Book of Irish Prayers & Blessings*." This little book is awesome and there is even a page in honor of St. Francis of Assisi. I want to leave you with St. Francis's prayer that he would pray in the morning, I've been saying it lately as well:

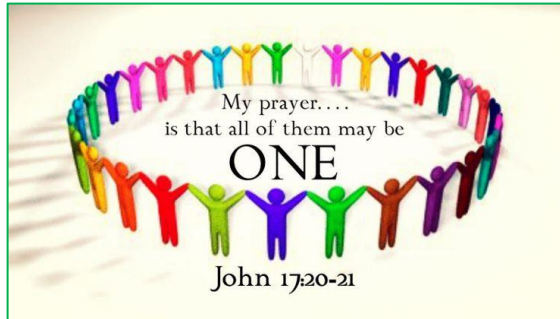

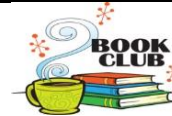
