My Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi, the truth that Jesus is really present in the Holy Eucharist. When our Lord returned to the glory of heaven, he promised he would be with us until the end of the ages. When the Jewish people were journeying in the desert, God gave them physical bread to sustain them; now we have the spiritual bread from heaven to sustain us in the joys and tribulations of life. It is always a blessing to be able to offer the Mass as a priest with all of you here at St. Francis. You know from my sermons that I have a tough time sleeping because my mind seems to ruminate about the worries of life, in the middle of the night, but whenever I get to offer the Mass and receive the Eucharist with all of you, I get the confirmation that our Lord is in charge and things will be okay—because I didn't receive a symbol of Jesus, I received Jesus truly present in the host.

I wanted to just make a quick mention about our St. Francis grotto. Our St. Francis statue has seen better days, and, on more than one occasion, the statue has fallen over and is in disrepair. I promise you the statue will be replaced but I am trying to find a good quality statue that will last for years to come. I appreciate your patience. We will replace the statue, add some lighting, and get the area power-washed—it just may take a bit of time, but it'll get done.

I hope everyone is having a relaxing summer and we finally get some sunshine. Our parish motto in honor of St. Francis is: Pax et Bonum, which means: Peace and good will to all. I hope all of you experience those two virtues in this summer of 2025!

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ ~ June 22nd

Genesis 14:18-20

The First Reading is a foretaste of the Eucharist. King Melchizedek of Salem serves bread and wine to Abram and blesses him in the name of the Lord. What does it mean that Jesus is a priest in the order of Melchizedek?

1 Corinthians 11:23-26

"For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes." These words from the second reading recount the first Supper of the Lord. Reflect on the following the next time you receive the Eucharist: Jesus takes the bread and wine of the Passover meal that he is eating with his disciples and presents them as *his Body broken on the Cross and his Blood poured out on the cross for the forgiveness of sins*. As you reflect how do these words bring you to a greater understanding and love for the Eucharist?

Luke 9:11b-17

The Gospel concludes with a simple meal for a hungry crowd. When we receive Christ's Body and Blood in the Eucharist, St. Augustine tells us "... we become what we receive." We become Jesus' Body in this world. St. Teresa of Avila also shares, "Christ has no body now but yours." Meditate and pray about your role as Christ's hands, eyes, and feet. Decide on one action this week by which you may serve as Christ's body in the world.
