This candle burns to remind us of the Sacramental Presence of Jesus Christ.



The those who fear him, / and delivers them." "I sought the Lord, and he answered me..." This describes Peter when he was thrown into prison by Herod Antipas, the son of the Herod who tried to have the infant Jesus killed. Is there a time when you sought the Lord, and he answered you?

2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18

While the readings show Peter at the high point of his ministry, they offer a glimpse of Paul at the end of his. In the second reading, the apostle Paul contemplates the end of his life with a sense of peaceful fulfillment. He has finished the race that God gave him to run. Now he looks forward with hope to his reward: eternal life with God. If you were to contemplate the end of your life at this moment, would you experience the same sense as Paul? If not, what changes in your life would you need to make?

Many leaders of the early Church risked their very lives to proclaim the Good News. Who took a risk to introduce you to Jesus? Who invited you to learn more about him? Reflect about the risks involved in sharing our faith, and the possible miracles that sharing faith can produce.


