

# BREAKING OPEN THE WORD 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ July 6th



#### Isaiah 66: 10-14c

The theme of joy connects the readings from Isaiah, Psalm 66 and the Gospel of Luke. In Isaiah, the Lord calls the people to rejoice and be glad along with Jerusalem. The Israelites had mourned over their beautiful city when she was dishonored and destroyed by the Babylonian empire. Now the healed and rebuilt city will be like a mother to them. God too describes himself as a mother who will comfort God's children, the chosen people, Israel.

When have you recently felt the comfort of our God?

#### **Galatians 6: 14-18**

In the Second Reading Paul declares that he will never boast in anything except the cross of Jesus. What does it mean for you to live so that we are "crucified to the world"?

#### Luke 10: 1-12, 17-20

In the Gospel reading, the seventy-two disciples who had been sent out ahead of Jesus, proclaiming God's kingdom and paving the way for Jesus' ministry, return to him rejoicing. Like the seventy-two whom he sends on mission, we are meant to do the same. When have you experienced joy in your evangelization efforts?


