The First Reading expresses the essence of Israel’s covenant relationship with God. In it Moses calls God’s people to embody the decrees that will bear fruit for generations to come. Foundational to this relationship of faith is love. What does it mean to you to love God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength?

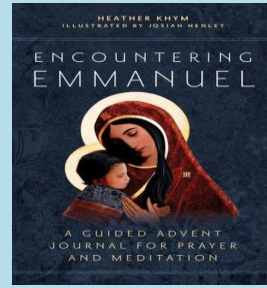
