

Breaking Open the Word 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time~ November 17, 2024



Daniel 12: 1-3

Daniel 12 reveals the climax of God's work in history. In apocalyptic writing, this passage comforts the afflicted through imagery of heavenly battle and earthly recompense. In it we find the claim for our own individual resurrection. How strongly do you follow the message given to us in this reading so as to claim this promise, "But the wise shall shine brightly like the splendor of the firmament, and those who lead the many to justice shall be like the stars forever?"

"...now he waits until his enemies are made his footstool." What are you doing to fight against God's enemies and the evil you find surrounding you?

Mark 13: 24-32

From listening to Jesus in today's Gospel, we can learn the importance of paying attention. We are to act wisely, turn others to righteousness, and wait. Advent is a season of waiting, a time to be marked by urgent anticipation, by a longing for the fulfillment of what has been promised. 
