Breaking Open the Word First Sunday of Advent ~ December 1st, 2024



Jeremiah 33:14-16

Christmas is drawing near, but the readings describe the end of the world. Christ's second coming in glory is one of the main themes of Advent, along with his arrival as an infant and his daily appearance in our lives through the Holy Spirit. How has Christ appeared in your life lately?

1 Thessalonians 3:12-4:2

The 2nd reading provides insights to those of us for whom the end of the world will be a disaster. As we await Christ's second coming, our job is to learn how to love and be holy, to place ourselves at the side of those who have nothing and to learn to love our persecutors." How do you plan to celebrate the season of Advent based on this challenge? Don't forget the parish Giving Tree. Plan to bring the gifts to St. Martin de Porres Parish on December 15th, too, if you can.

Luke 21:25-28, 34-36

Christians in every age have struggled to find the Good News in these end-of-the-world prophecies. The gospel foretells cosmic tribulation and predicts famine, earthquakes, and the destruction of nations. The end of the world is good news to people for whom the systems of the world do not function, the losers in economic and political games, and those who have had to sacrifice the things they need so that others can have what they want or need. Will you lose or gain when Christ comes again? How can you "stand erect" with those Christ has come to save?
