

Breaking Open the Word 2nd Sunday of Advent ~ December 8th, 2024



Baruch 5:1-9

Advent is underway. The first reading and the Psalm point to themes of exile, return/deliverance, and the power of the Mighty God. These themes mirror the Church's call for repentance during Advent to welcome the Mighty God to enter into our situation and restore our lives. How do you plan to prepare your heart for Christmas through repentance?

<u>Philippians 1:4-6, 8 – 11</u>

The 2nd reading, the letter from Saint Paul, inspires us to remember the work God is doing within us and through us; by God's grace this work of holiness will continue to grow. What work of God is he doing within you and through you at this time? If you are not aware, ask him to lead you to follow one of the Spiritual or Corporal Works of Mercy. He will answer you!

Luke 3:1-6

John the Baptist was chosen to prepare the people of his time for Christ. If you had to prepare the world for Christ, what would your message be?




