

Breaking Open the Word 4th Sunday of Advent ~ December 22nd, 2024



Micah 5:1-4a

Which Centuries before the birth of Jesus, the prophet Micah foretold that the tiny town of Bethlehem would be host to the birth of the long-awaited Savior. The readings this week provide a reminder that small things often have great consequence in God's eyes, but only those attentive to the will of God notice them. 

Dear Jesus.

It's halfway through Advent and I'm not sure what happened. Thank You, Jesus. It's not too late. You are waiting to enter my life today, wherever I let You in. Help me to open my heart in these remaining days. Amen.




