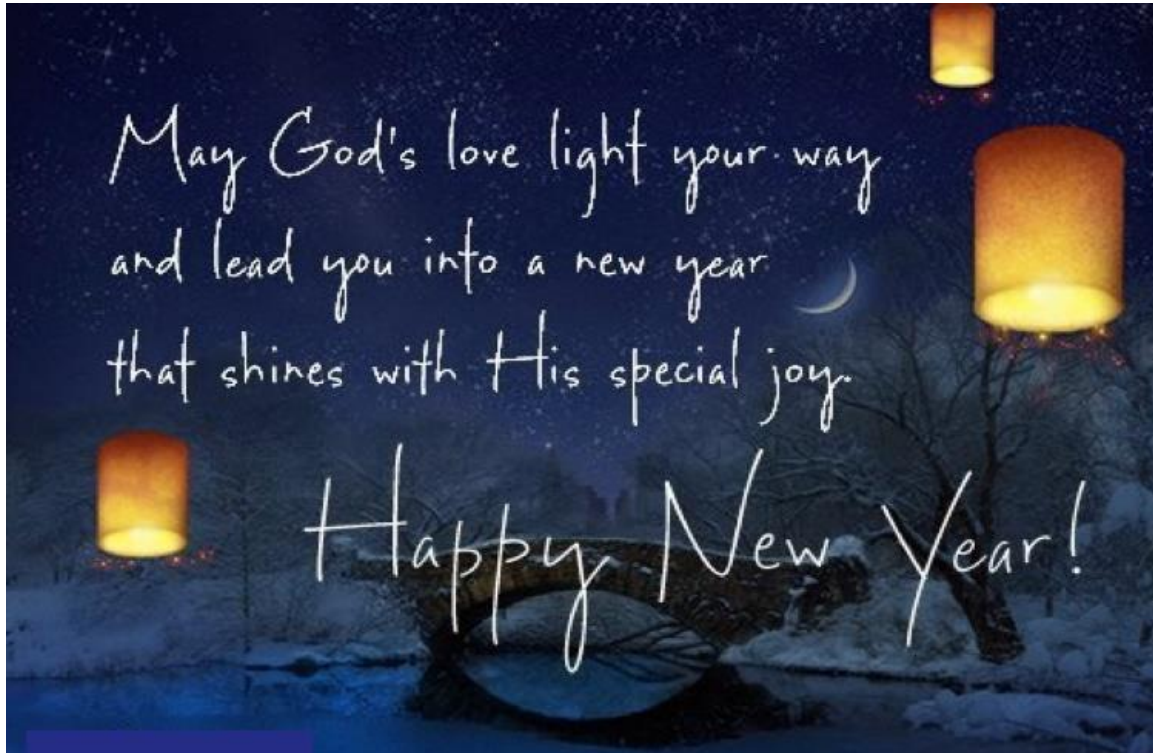

Breaking Open the Word
The Epiphany of the Lord ~ January 5, 2025



Isaiah 60:1-6

The Greek epiphaneia means “manifestation” or “appearance” and indicates that we now commemorate God’s gift of the Christ to all humankind in Jesus of Nazareth. The prophet Isaiah proclaims the light shining in the darkness of the world. Reflect on the concept of “epiphany” and the multifaceted ways God can manifest in your life.

Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6

Paul’s letter to the Ephesians tells of God’s stewardship of creation. Gentiles, coheirs of God’s plan for the salvation of all humankind alongside their Jewish brethren, fully express the revelation of God through the grace of God’s manifold wisdom. The true people of God are made up of all kinds, perfected in the eternal purpose accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord. God can use any and all possibilities creation offers to reveal himself to those he calls for diverse purposes. Considering Paul’s summons in his letter, how diverse are the people and purposes in your life? How might you broaden your openness to the wisdom and revelation of God?

Matthew 2:1-12

Matthew’s Gospel tells of the Christ child, born in Bethlehem in the time of King Herod, who had a death wish for all potential claimants to his status and throne. After the Gentile wise men are profoundly affected by their encounter with the Christ child and his family, they make their own way in the world, defying the powers that be. In what ways might God be calling you to defy the status quo- your own or society’s. How could this benefit you and those around you.

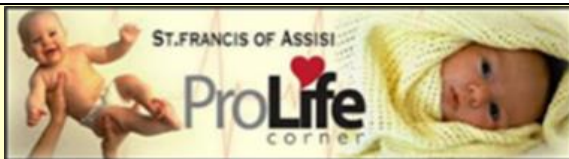

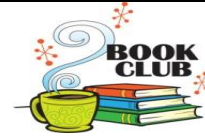
