

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

Easter Sunday ~March 31st, 2024 Acts 10:34a, 37-43

".... He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.... everyone who believes in Him will receive forgiveness of sins through His name...." Can you recall when you were at your lowest moments? They could have been due to physical agony or spiritual anguish. Possibly both. To Whom did you reach out in fervent prayer and supplication for not only healing but also a forgiveness and expunging of those sins which gnaw at your very soul? Do you understand the simple yet profound curative power of Christ's love which is always yours if you choose to reach out?

Colossians 3:1-4

"... If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above... ...not of what is on earth...." In what ways do you find it difficult to look up? Literally. How often do you stare straight ahead (not talking about driving/walking but times e.g. when you are fixated on the flatscreen) or peering down (most likely at a cellphone) instead of raising your eyes heavenward? Can you see how this serves as a spiritual metaphor? How easy it is to be ensnared in things of this temporal, fleeting world which can often drag you down? Perhaps you can seek what is above by little adjustments. Scroll through your phone for meditations or tune into a show about prayerful reflection. You can elevate your electronic devices toward a higher and more fulfilling purpose.

John 20:1-9

"...the other disciple also went in.... he saw and

believed....." Can you see how the other disciple 'connected the dots' when he arrived at the tomb?

He recalled the Jesus Who went about doing good and healing people. Then that apostle did not look at what was here below, an empty tomb. He lifted up his mind, heart and soul and focused on the Resurrected Christ Who is one with His Father in Heaven.






