BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

Fifth Sunday of Easter ~ April 28th, 2024



Acts 9:26-31

When Saul (Paul) arrived in Jerusalem he tried to join the Christian community, but the people were understandably fearful of him. His reputation was difficult to overcome. Put yourself in the place of those gathered in Jerusalem. Can you relate to their suspicions? How might that situation have relevance today?

1 John 3:18-24

"Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth." If you were charged with having an intimate relationship with God, what evidence (deed and truth) would your accusers find to convict you?

John 15:1-8

This extended season of Easter is a reminder of the dying and rising of Christ for the Christian life. These Sundays after Easter afford us with tine to reflect upon the deepest meanings of our life in Christ, flowing from Baptism and the continual presence of the Holy Spirit. In what way does this Gospel invite you to enter more deeply into the Paschal Mystery? What does it mean to you personally that Jesus is the vine and you are the branches? How do you feel about being pruned? Have you ever felt that you were pruned by the Vinedresser? What did you learn from this experience?
