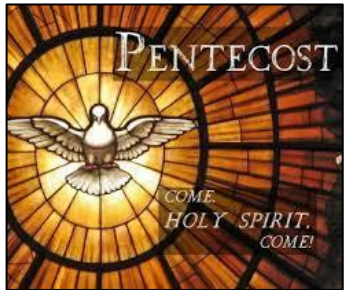

Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40

In the First Reading Moses recalls to God's chosen people all the great things they experienced from God before their very eyes...the voice of God speaking from the midst of fire, and God taking a nation for Himself by testing's, signs, and wonders. Recall a time when you experienced the power of God in some clear way in your life. Is that memory always before you or, like the Israelites, do you need reminders of God's intervention in your life?
