Today we celebrate the glorious Feast of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi).

Saint Paul told the Corinthians "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." ---1 Corinthians 11:26

"Both bread and wine are made by gathering the many and crushing them into a unified substance. Crushing many grains of wheat and molding them into one substance makes bread. Crushing grapes into juice and letting the juice age and ferment makes wine. The Church, which is the Body of Christ, is made up of the "many" who are made one through the sacrifice of Christ. In the preparatory rites of the Liturgy of the Eucharist (which literally means "giving thanks"), we prepare to offer ourselves, along with the priest, to God the Father in union with the one Sacrifice of Christ."
