**BREAKING OPEN THE WORD**

The 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time ~ July 21st, 2024



**Jeremiah 23:1-6**

“I myself will gather the remnant of my flock and bring them back to their meadow...I will appoint shepherds for them...” God’s promise in Jeremiah is to do no less than to bring His people home to safety so that “they need no longer “fear and tremble.” Do we know in our hearts that we are God’s own flock, and that He will see to our safety now and in the future? Do we also know that God might be calling us to help shepherd His flock? If so, how will you answer the call?

**Ephesians 2: 13-18**

Peace and reconciliation. We may be distant in time from those to whom Paul preached, but we are as much in need of peace and reconciliation as they were. And Paul tells us how we might have both – through Jesus- who gives us access “in one Spirit” to the Father. How will you take some time this week to see out the peace that you need? 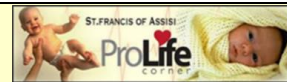

**The Prayer Network**

Join our Prayer Network and become a Prayer Warrior. A PRAYER NETWORK is the work of a silent, unobtrusive group of people who offer to "stand in the breach" and intercede for the serious needs of fellow parishioners, their families and friends.

Since *prayer is its only purpose*, a parish prayer network can become a spiritual community builder unlike any other Church group. There is NO ORGANIZATION to it. It requires NO MEETINGS, NO OFFICERS, and NO ACTIVITIES. The "pray-ers" who volunteer can choose whatever kind of prayer they are led to use, for as long as they feel the Lord desires them to do so. A telephone call comes, needs are expressed and a prayer (usually a Hail Mary and Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You) are prayed with the caller. The recipient calls the next person on the line and repeats the process. A prayer or two may be said during the day for those intentions. Your prayer may be an ejaculation (My Jesus, Mercy), a rosary or whatever prayer you are most comfortable with.

We would hope that the family would pray together for the intentions, thus exposing the children to praying for the needs of others. This is one small way we can "love one another" as Jesus has commanded us. No one should ever have to feel alone in their suffering or time of crisis.
