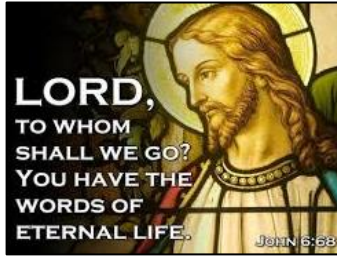

The 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time ~ August 25th, 2024



Joshua 24: 1-2a, 15-17, 18b

Joshua challenges God's people to declare where they stand, even in unsettled times. What might be a similar situation today? Could you respond with such conviction...therefore we will also serve the lord, for he is our God? Spend some intentional time reflecting on your actions from this past week.
