

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD The 22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time ~ September 1st Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8

"...In your observance of the commandments of the LORD, your God.... you shall not add to what I command you nor subtract from it...."

When I was a boy, I might 'overdo it' when keeping some commandment. My Mom would say, "*Do you think you're holier than the Church?*" Meaning why my need to go past the precepts of Jesus? Granted I could also go the 'other way' and backslide.

Today's first reading addresses 'going overboard' like a Pharisee, fixating on needlessly adding to '*God's Law*'. Can you recall times when you do this? Conversely, can you remember when you gravitate the other way? About when you fail to adhere to the '*Spirit* of God's Law by subtracting from it? Cutting corners? Avoiding the tough parts?

James 1:17-18, 21B-22, 27

".... Humbly welcome the Word that has been planted in you.... Be doers of the Word and not hearers only..."

Do you see how the second reading perfectly complements the first? How it guides you to first welcome '*God's Word*' planted in your heart? Can you recall times though when you only heard the Word but failed to follow through? How you were not a 'doer' of the Word by carrying it out?

Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

"...the Pharisees and scribes questioned Jesus, "Why do your disciples not follow the tradition of the elders.... Our Lord responded, "Well did Isaiah prophesy about you hypocrites, 'This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me... Can you see how this Gospel passage really brings it 'home' for these readings? Do you understand how today's readings show how, even in matters of faith, that 'things come in threes'? How each reading builds logically and emotionally upon the preceding one? This week, might you spend some time silently to reflect deeply about the symmetry and synergy of this spiritual sustenance? How it breaks down into three digestible parts?
