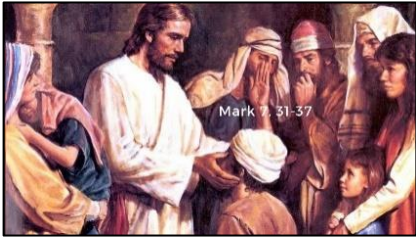

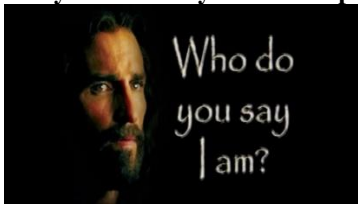

BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

The 24th Sunday of Ordinary Time ~ September 15th



Isaiah 50:4c-9a

“...The Lord GOD opens my ear that I may hear... The Lord GOD is my help...”

Can you recall that moment when after hearing something explained to you many times over, you suddenly ‘get it’? Maybe you had to mature. Perhaps you had to really slow down and truly listen.

In what manner might this same situation be applicable to your relationship with God? How many days and in how many ways has the Lord imparted His ‘Mighty Whispers’ into your ears?

How would you describe that ‘thunderbolt’ experience where your spiritual ‘hearing’ is finally opened up to the transformational truth that, no matter what challenge or difficulty or trial you encounter, you now know God is always your help?

James 2:14-18

“.... demonstrate my faith to you from my works...”

Reflect on the first reading. What do you think you are supposed to do after really ‘hearing’ God speaking to you? In grade school when the teacher caught a student with candy during class, the question that was asked was, ***“Do you have enough for the other students?”*** It was a ‘tongue-in-cheek’ way to discipline the wayward pupil, meaning that the child was to share this sweet item with others.

Can you see how, in this second reading, the Lord challenges you in the same manner with regard to sweet gift of Faith? How will you live out the answer to the question, ***“Do you have enough to share with others?”***

Mark 8:27-35

spiritually? ***“...whoever loses his life for My sake will save it...”*** Can you discern how the Gospel builds upon the foundation of the first two readings?

First: Open your ears to God. Second: Demonstrate that you have heard Him by what you do.

Can you see how the Gospel takes you to the ultimate challenge? It is not just by doing good deeds here and there. It is by a complete surrender to God, forsaking the false and fickle allures of this temporal world, while focusing mind, heart and actions on the eternal, transcendent kingdom.

Can you try to set your spirit on this course as best you can?

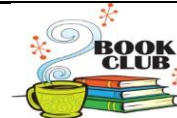
