BREAKING OPEN THE WORD



The 25th Sunday of Ordinary Time ~ September 22nd Wisdom 2:12; 17-20

"...for according to his own words, God will take care of him..."

In what ways can you reflect upon your daily words and how they represent your Christian faith? Can you discern how well you speak to others, in the workplace, in social settings, in your home in a dignified manner which honors others as children of God? Finally, in what manner do you see how your words shape your actions? When you choose a respectful response when disagreeing with someone? When you patiently engage in a needed conversation even when your nerves might be frayed? By taking care in those situations, God will make sure to take care of you.

James 2:14-18

".... wisdom from above is first of all pure, then peaceable, gentle, compliant, full of mercy ..."

Can you see how this reading flows logically from the first? Words and Wisdom are intertwined. Your verbal expressions can be beautiful outpourings of the blessing of Wisdom from God...if you so choose.

However, might you see how things can go so very wrong when you listen to your baser instincts? Choose deceit over honesty. Select greed over generosity. Seek vengeance over justice. In those three examples which options do you think Jesus would employ?

Mark 9:30-37

"...If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all ...

In baseball there is a term for the first two batters, those who 'set the table' (that is, get on base) for the 'heart' of the line-up (the number three, four, five hitters --home run sluggers) to drive them home to provide the runs to help the team win.

Can you see how the first two readings 'set the table' for the Gospel, the 'heart' of God's Word? First Reading tells you what to do, choose your words carefully. Second Reading tells you how, by selecting Wisdom. Gospel drives those points home, like a slugger driving crucial runs home. It is done simply yet beautifully. Words bespeak Wisdom which is lived out by the actions of serving others and putting their needs first.
