



BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

The 26th Sunday of Ordinary Time ~ September 29th



Numbers 11:25-29

"... Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets!" What are your thoughts when you think whether you could be a prophet? What is your 'gut feeling'? One of discomfort? An incredulous 'Nah, not me. I'm not that holy.' reaction?

Ponder further for a moment. Didn't Jesus call on ALL of us to be His disciples? The Lord does not say you have to be an Isaiah level prophet. Or John the Baptist.

Christ says I need a 'regular person next door\neighbor\Little League volunteer\hard working person from Springfield' to prophesy My words in your daily loving actions.

Hey, that's you! That's me. I just think we might be able to do that. Right?

James 5:1-6

".... Your wealth has rotted away..."

Hmm, kind of interesting. Reflect on the first reading. The focus is on what? Being a **prophet**.

What does the second reading home in on? People worried about human **profit.**

Read James' passage slowly. It is not a long one. Does it seem like a happy tale? The folks who hoarded their wealth don't seem to be doing too well, do they?

Why do you think?

Maybe a little more focus on being a prophet versus making a profit would have been called for?

"... For whoever is not against us is for us...."

Humanity has unfortunately has always struggled with divisions. The pages of history are replete of splits and schisms which have horrendous consequences.

Can you see where so many of the world's disputes originated from people's pre-occupation with the '*Letter*' of God's Law while losing focus on the '*Spirit*' of God's Law?

In what ways can you seek to build bridges by finding common cause with those who share in the Spirit of God's Law versus constructing walls of division by obsessing on the Letter?


